Crystal Downs is a thinking man's course, where long is good but not necessary, where the position one leaves his ball is critical, and where the wind always blows. Dr. Alister Mackenzie designed this great layout after having completed his two most noted courses. Holes #5 and #6 are two of Mackenzie's best anywhere, #5 at 345 suggests "don't bite off too much" or trouble will begin and #6 at 351 lend to the idea of a "forced carry". If you make the crest of the hill, a short iron to the largest green on the course awaits you. However, if you fall short, a blind long iron is necessary and the famous "Scabs", the bunkers that sit on the hill side suggest "Don't even think about it!"

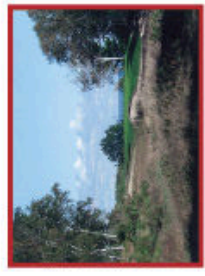
