The short holes, by which a golf course generally stands or falls, are all first class. They include the "Redan", "Eden", "Short" and the "Biarritz". The longer holes are well conceived, and they include two or three of the "dog's hind leg" variety, with out which no modern course is complete. The ground of The Old White, is naturally undulating, presenting many natural features which lend an individuality to each hole, while the river makes a splendid water hazard for some holes. It is difficult to imagine a more fortunate combination of circumstances which MacDonald/Raynor have created.
