The classic elements of golf course design are adhered to in the design of Calusa Pines. Hurzden and Fry created the routing so that all the par 5's and par 3's are played in different directions due to the Florida winds, with the par 3's requiring a varied club selection from a nine iron to a driver, while the par 5's are reachable with two well struck shots and favorable wind conditions. Two interesting short par 4's - #8 and #14 - were conceived as fun yet essential design varieties as was the proper mix of fade versus draw shots from various tees. Thus, the classic statement - "tough par, relatively easy bogey" applies to this course, "it's hard to get lucky at Calusa Pines".
