The forces of nature are on display at Hazelton. On a piece of ground where the woods battled the prairie for dominance over the centuries, the golfer is faced with a mixture of both. Water also comes into play with hazards guarding a number of holes, with the fearsome challenge of Hazelton Lake, on #16, playing on a golfer's mind long before he steps on that tee. If you are out of position at Hazelton National, you are always hitting your ball over something! At times, it is a natural feature of land and at times it is one of the many strategically placed bunkers that guard the greens. This is the course that defines the game, as tough a test as you find!



There is no compromising on the 16th at Hazelton, with a tight tee shot to a fairway bounded by trees and an approach shot to an angled green surrounded on three sides by water.
