



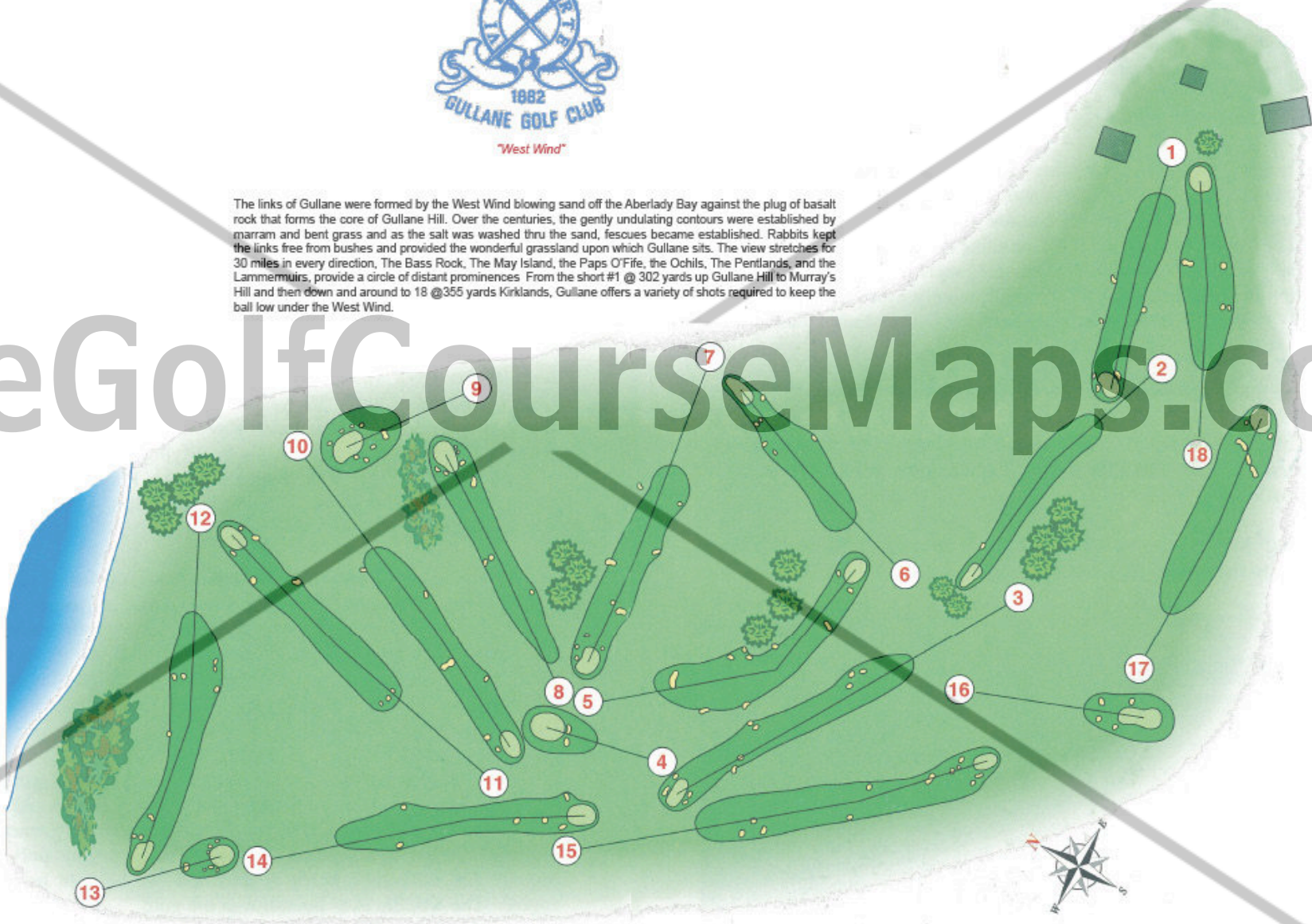
The links of Gullane were formed by the West Wind blowing sand off the Aberlady Bay against the plug of basalt rock that forms the core of Gullane Hill. Over the centuries, the gently undulating contours were established by marram and bent grass and as the salt was washed thru the sand, fescues became established. Rabbits kept the links free from bushes and provided the wonderful grassland upon which Gullane sits. The view stretches for 30 miles in every direction, The Bass Rock, The May Island, the Paps O'Fife, the Ochils, The Pentlands, and the Lammermuirs, provide a circle of distant prominences. From the short #1 @ 302 yards up Gullane Hill to Murray's Hill and then down and around to 18 @ 355 yards Kirklands, Gullane offers a variety of shots required to keep the ball low under the West Wind.
