Prairie Dunes is an American original and one of the most scenic courses anywhere. You could never mistake pictures of it for an other American course, although it is easily confused with some of the best in the British Isles. Prairie Dunes is the "Hidden Treasure" of Hutchinson Kansas. Sam Snead once said to the gallery as he approached the 1st tee at Prairie Dunes, "Kids, we'll have to walk single file to day", referring to the narrow treeless that define the course. Thickets and cavernous bunkers surround most of the greens, await each 2nd shot, eating them up with common regularity. Holes #2-5-10 have been listed as 3 of the best 100 holes in America. #2 is a dangerous par 3 at 181 yards, #8 is considered the toughest hole @ 430 yards (and not named "Loop Luck") and #10, is termed by course architect Perry Maxwell as the best par 3 in America, ... probably not.
