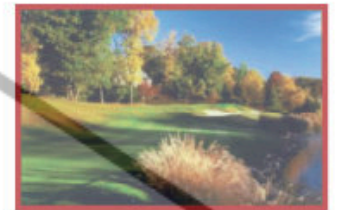

Willie Park, Jr. was a "Naturalist" who believed that golf holes were not made, but found. Park's routing at Woodway is as natural as could be achieved in that it follows the flow of the ridges and gullies which in turn can lure the player into thinking aggressively, while at the same time, the risk is ever so present! The key to success at Woodway is staying dry: 17 water hazards affect play on 15 holes. The course plays over rolling terrain, with a number of greens sitting atop natural plateaus. Most are tightly bunkered and sharply contoured. Clearly, Park has taken advantage of the natural beauty of the setting, making Woodway a most delightful course with a championship venue.
