Called the "Shangri-La of golf" the course reflects a true integration of the game and the environment. The course features remnants of coal mining activity, including exposed, strip-mined high walls, a rotary car tippie, coal laden mine cars, a cart path through a once active deep mine, and waterfalls that originate from deep mining days gone by. These features along with Pete Dye's spectacular framework surrounding the golf course have created 18 of the most exciting and memorable holes a player can imagine. The 18th hole at 475 yards is perhaps the most stunning inland finishing hole in the states!
