

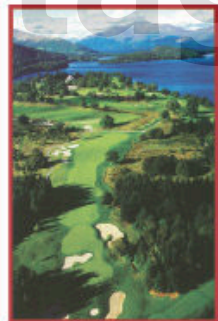


**Loch Lomond

The opening nine holes are set within mostly open ground, to the east side of the property, with the loch never far away and the hills ever-present in the distance. The stunning scenery never overwhelms the course, but it does distract the less than assiduous golfer. Distraction is a theme that runs throughout the course; from bunkers that guide rather than hinder a golfer; to trees that do not really affect strategy but do play games with the golfer's mind; to fairways that are wider than they seem and greens made smaller by hidden slopes; and, most of all, to the beauty of the natural environment, which cannot and should not be ignored. Loch Lomond is "a three-dimensional camouflage of the most effective kind!"

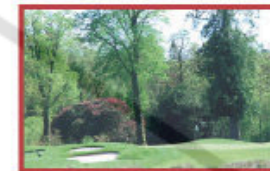


The 2nd and 4th - Double Green
