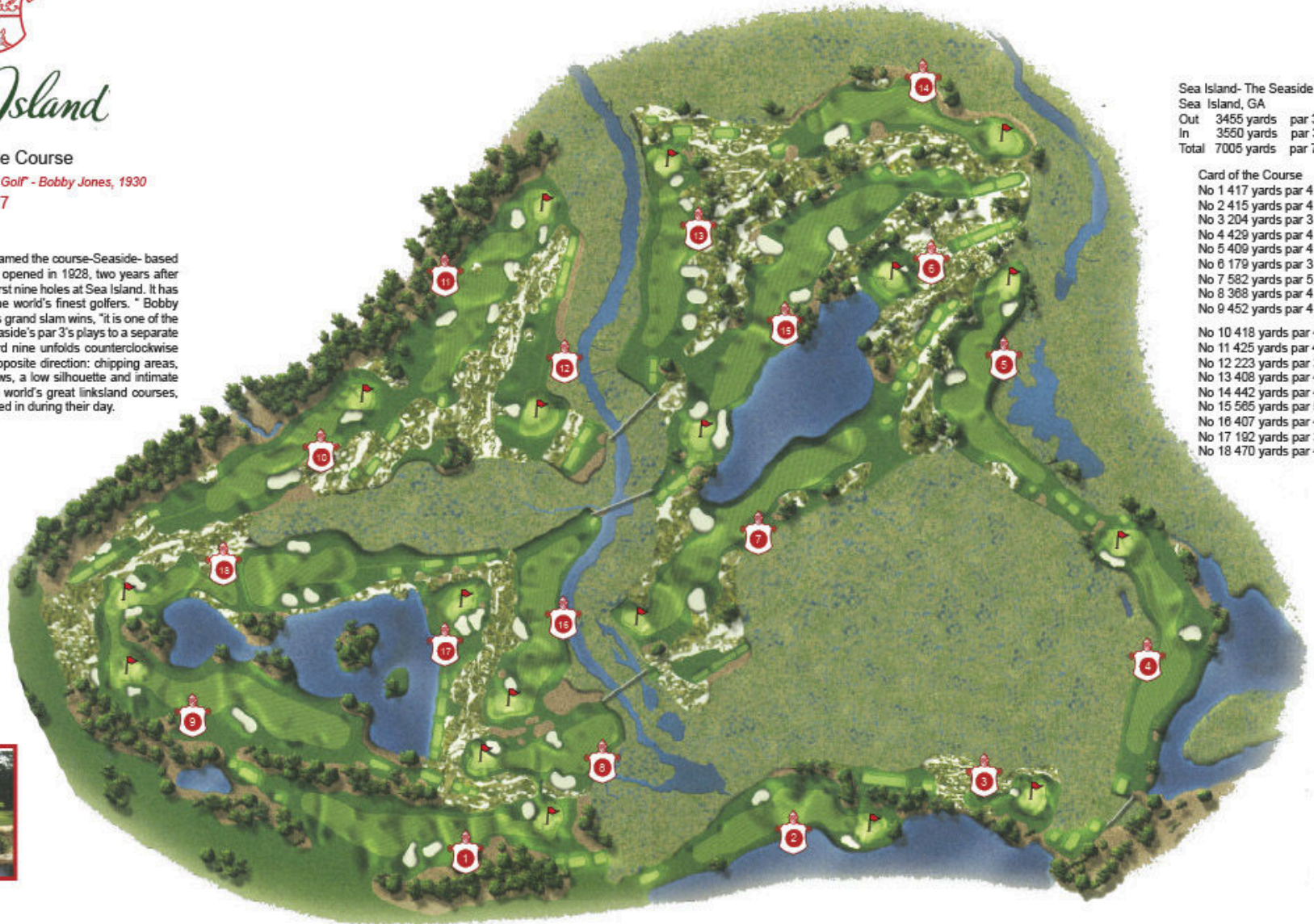
## The Seaside Course

*"one of the best nine holes in Golf" - Bobby Jones, 1930*  
1927

Harry S Colt and Charles Alison named the course-Seaside- based on the 2nd nine holes which was opened in 1928, two years after Walter Travis had completed the first nine holes at Sea Island. It has always captured the respect of the world's finest golfers. Bobby Jones said in 1930, in between his grand slam wins, "it is one of the best nine holes in golf" Each of Seaside's par 3's plays to a separate point of the compass: the outward nine unfolds counterclockwise as the inward nine plays in the opposite direction: chipping areas, wide sweeping bunkers, long views, a low silhouette and intimate hillocks are all reminiscent of the world's great linksland courses, which Colt and Alison were involved in during their day.
