Cape Kidnappers has perhaps the longest entrance road to play golf – it takes 15 minutes to reach the first tee from the gate and once there, the 440 yard opener poses a far from easy start, with its green sitting on the diagonal from the right to left and guarded by bunkers on the left, clearly rewarding the drive to the right side of the hole. From that start, there are memorable golfing moments with adventurous 2nd shots to par 5's and epic shots across ravines #8, then mental challenges 12-15 offering cliff hanging shots to par 3's, par 5's that are over 645 yards #15 which run along the cliff wall, and then the closing holes, 16-18, highlighted by the punchbowl green at 18 which entices the player to take dead aim. The course is visually intimidating, breathtaking!
