The 4th

Emerald Dunes, a jewel, in the world of Florida golf courses, is a Tom Fazio special. Built on a billiard table terrain, the architect created a special golf experience. The routing is circular and thus creates a variety of shot requirements necessary in the Florida winds. There are ten dogleg holes on the course route, which complicate the very need for correct positioning. The peak of the course is a mountain, perhaps at the top over 75 feet from land, created in the courses center from which the 11th and 18th holes start their trek. The key element at Emerald Dunes is judging the wind and placing one's ball in the correct area for the next shot.
