



# HARDING PARK

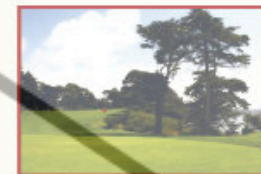
*"A Good Park Unspoiled"*

Harding Park was opened in 1925, designed by Willie Watson and Sam Whiting, who had completed The Olympic Club a couple of miles down Skyline Blvd on the other side of Lake Merced. It was named after President Warren G. Harding, an avid golfer, who had died in San Francisco at the Palace Hotel.

It is the routing of Harding Park that gives part of its charm. The front nine winds around the interior part of the property and the back nine circles around the perimeter so that the last five holes are played along the shore of Lake Merced. What a view!
