In 1964 Ken Venturi won this Donald Ross special, in a dramatic and emotional U.S. Open here. Battling brutal heat, physical exhaustion and the field itself in the last 36 hole one day marathon the USGA held, he closed out the win with a final putt at 18, which brought tears to the eyes of many including his playing partner Ray Floyd. Ernie Els won the Open in 1997 finishing strong on the last 3 holes. In 2011, the US Open returns to Congressional and #18 becomes #10 @190 yards while the 1997 #17 becomes #18 at 466 yards par 4 down hill to the pond lurking behind!
