Although short by modern America standards, Olympic's Lakeside plays long because the moist San Francisco climate limits roll and carry. Narrow fairways and small greens strengthen its challenge. 30,000 pined, cedars, and eucalyptus and cypress trees dominate the Olympic course and are always a hazard, as evidenced in the 1955 Open.
