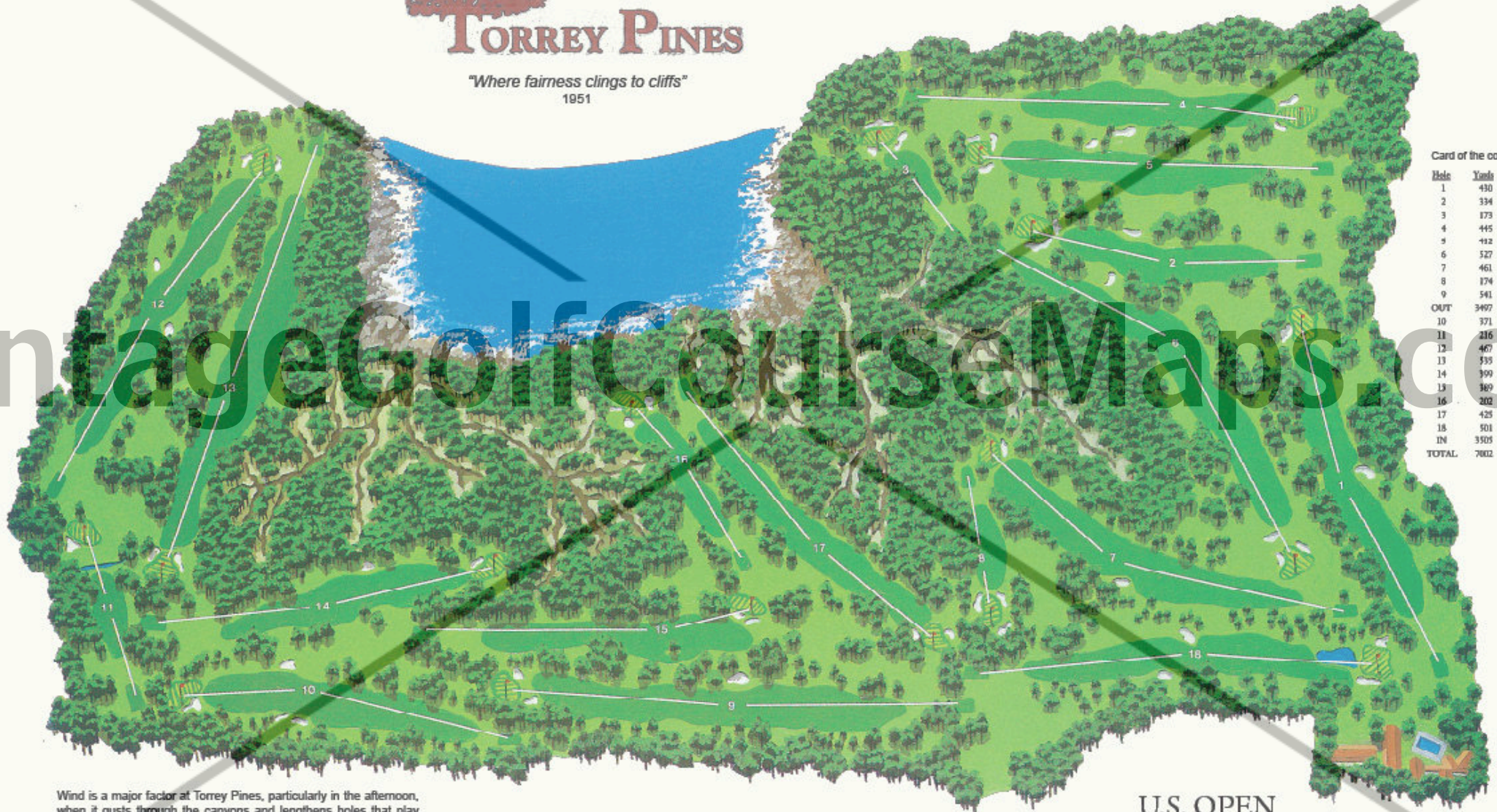

Most of the trees on the course are the starkly beautiful Torrey Pines, an ancient variety of long needle fir, native only to sand.
