

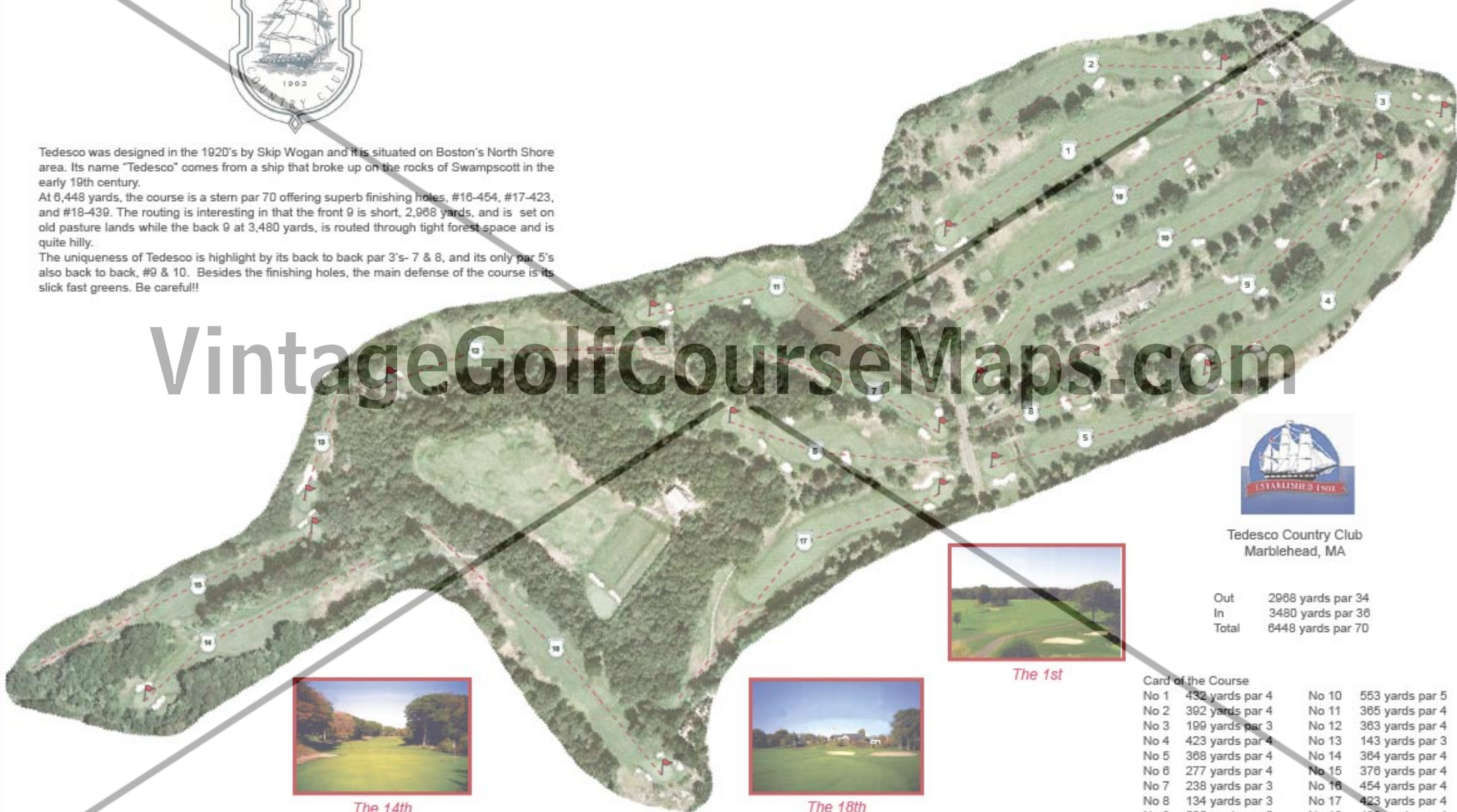


Tedesco was designed in the 1920's by Skip Wogan and it is situated on Boston's North Shore area. Its name "Tedesco" comes from a ship that broke up on the rocks of Swampscott in the early 19th century.

At 6,448 yards, the course is a stern par 70 offering superb finishing holes, #16-454, #17-423, and #18-439. The routing is interesting in that the front 9 is short, 2,968 yards, and is set on old pasture lands while the back 9 at 3,480 yards, is routed through tight forest space and is quite hilly.

The uniqueness of Tedesco is highlight by its back to back par 3's- 7 & 8, and its only par 5's also back to back, #9 & 10. Besides the finishing holes, the main defense of the course is its slick fast greens. Be careful!!
