Somerset Hills is a course of great beauty and charm, perennially listed among the top 100 courses in the country. Its two nines were created in "Contrasting Styles", the front side originally laid out over barren terrain on the old Olcott race track and its predominant features are numerous mounds and small, high-lipped bunkers cut from the sides of mounds. The back nine is heavily wooded with far fewer bunkers and mounds, but water on four holes. Great par 3's highlight Somerset, the 2nd "REDAN" considered one of the best of its kind, The green on the par 3 12th "DESPAIR" is a peninsula that extends into the pond bordering the left side, lending an aura of 16 at Augusta and the 15th "HAPPY VALLEY" perhaps the course's most memorable hole, is a dogleg right par 4 that runs downhill from the fairway to a the largest green on the course and this green is guarded by a creek that becomes a cascading waterfall at the entry.
